

EVALUATION

The evaluation in every module of each semester comprises of two components.

- **Continuous Assessment:**

The candidate is assessed continuously throughout the semester by Continuous Assessment Tests (CAT I, II, Model) and Assignments. This constitutes **40%** of the evaluation.

- **Evaluation through End Semester Examination** constitutes **60%**.

GRADING:

- Grades A+, A, B+, B, C, F and I are awarded corresponding to the assessment.
- Grade points of 5.0, 4.0, 3.0, 2.0 and 1.0 are awarded respectively in each module according to the grade and the Grade Point Average (GPA) for each semester.
